2011-2012 SCHOLARSHIP TERMS

All Rock School Scholarship recipients are subject to the following terms:

- Attend all regularly scheduled dance classes to which he/she is assigned and will report all upcoming absences promptly to The Rock School's administrative office (215) 551-7010.
- Adhere to the student dress code established by The Rock School.
- Be polite, respectful, and supportive of fellow students, staff, and faculty.
- Not discuss scholarship information with other students and parents.

Additionally, the following terms are applicable to those students awarded a Dance Merit, Rock Academics, and/or Residence Scholarship:

DANCE MERIT SCHOLARSHIP | Ladies and Men Level 2X-6

- Render assistance to The Rock School and its staff if and when asked.
- Disclose all prior and current injuries and any major physical health problems that would interfere with his/her dancing to the School Directors fully and in a timely manner.
- Pledge his/her availability to participate fully in all rehearsals, performances, and other Rock School programs to which he/she is assigned.
- Maintain his/her physique to conform to aesthetic standards of the ballet profession.
- Exhibit consistent effort, artistic progress, disciplined and responsible behavior.
- Agree to remain an exclusive student of The Rock School (may not take outside dance classes or receive private coaching or lessons from another instructor and/or institution, unless given permission by The Rock School Directors.)
- Be available to rehearse for and participate in School-related lecture demonstrations, mini-performances, photography and videotaping sessions, interviews, fundraising functions, receptions, and similar functions.

ROCK ACADEMICS SCHOLARSHIP

- Be punctual for all Rock Academic sessions and courses to which he/she is enrolled/assigned.
- Deal honestly and respectfully with all members of the academic program.
- Will neither give nor receive unauthorized aid, as defined by my teachers both explicitly and implicitly, from any source on exams homework, quizzes, papers, or any other academic endeavor.
- Will demonstrate stewardship of the school environment, including all school property, areas and buildings around the school, the residential quarters, and the personal property of others.
- Will treat the school's laptop computer with great care and respect.
